

Band of Colours+ Drop In Policies & Expectations

- Everyone has the right to choose their name/pronouns, and it is expected that everyone respects those identities
- Everyone has the right to access the Drop In Resources and Support
- Everyone has the right to feel included in the Band of Colours community
- Everyone has the right to feel safe in a non-judgmental space, & it is expected to keep personal conflicts outside of Drop In
- Everyone is expected to respect the staff, volunteers, guests, and Drop In participants
- Everyone has the right to be listened to, and everyone is expected to listen
- Everyone is expected to respect the space Pat Porter has offered us, and stay within the designated areas
- Everyone has the right to privacy, and it is expected that what is said during Drop In, remains within Drop In

If you are unable to adhere to this agreement you will be asked by a volunteer to leave Drop In. Permission to return to Drop In will be granted on a case by case basis.
